## **Triage and Ocular Emergencies**

## **Classifications:**

Emergent – Immediate examination is required.

Urgent – Examination within 24-48 hours

Elective/Routine – Examination in 1-2 weeks

## **10 Basic Questions:**

- 1. What is the problem?
- 2. When did the problem start?
- 3. Is the eye painful?
- 4. Which eye, right eye, left eye, or both?
- 5. Are there any vision changes?
- 6. Is this an injury? How was it injured? When was it injured?
- 7. Do you have any chronic eye problems or conditions? Do you use any eye drops?
- 8. Are you monocular?
- 9. Have you had recent eye surgery, laser, or other eye procedure?
- 10. Do you wear contact lenes?

## **Your Role**

- 1. Be calm, courteous, and reassuring.
- 2. Determine the chief complaint.
- 3. Listen to the patient, they often know how serious their situation is.
- 4. When in doubt error on the side of caution.
- 5. Don't hesitate to ask questions to your supervisor or physician if you are unsure.
